No-EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING

- A recent change in the law allows a registered voter to request and vote an absentee ballot *without specifying a reason* for the 2010 Primary Election Date on February 2, 2010.
- A registered voter can obtain an application to *vote absentee by mail or in person at their County Clerk's Office or Election Authority.*
- A registered Voter can vote absentee in person at their County Clerk's Office or Authority beginning December 24, 2009 until February 1, 2010
- A registered voter may apply to their County Clerk or Election Authority to vote absentee by mail:
 - in the United States from **December 24, 2009 to January 27, 2010**
 - outside the United States from **December 24, 2009 to January 2, 2010**
