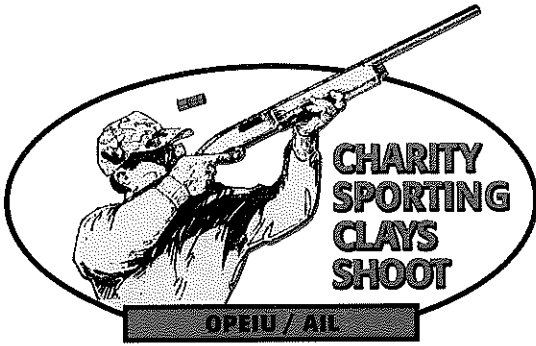

DIRECTIONS:

From I-90 or points south: take the Elgin, Route 25 exit and turn right (north) onto Route 25. Go past one traffic light (Brandt Drive, just north of the I-90 overpass) and turn left into the main entrance at the first break in the center divider after the Brandt Drive traffic light (0.15 miles north of the light). If you pass the Milk Pail Restaurant you have gone too far.

From the north: from the junctions of Routes 25 and 72, south on Route 25 exactly 1.45 miles to the main gate on the right. The entrance is the first drive on the right after the Milk Pail Restaurant (0.25 miles south of the Milk Pail).
